

**Title:** Radtke, Anton (Tony) Papers

**Abstract:** Tony Radtke served with Company E, 4th Wisconsin Regiment during the Spanish-American War but saw no action. He enlisted on July 26, 1899, and was assigned to Company F, 30<sup>th</sup> U.S. Infantry. His unit was sent to the Philippines to help put down the Filipino insurrection.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of correspondence from Radtke to his mother, Annie, and describes conditions in the Philippines as well as Camp Douglas, Wisconsin, and Camp Shipp, Alabama.
