**Abstract:** William Stock and his wife Ann operated a butcher shop from 1937 until 1942, when they broadened the scope of their business to a complete food market. The shop was located on Oakland Avenue. In 1960, the Stocks sold their inventory, and William went to work as a butcher at Rupena's Food Market until his death in 1972.
