Abstract: Beulah Meyer was born around 1920. She married LeRoy Miller on May 30, 1942, thereby becoming part of the long-standing Meyer homestead in Oak Creek. Sometime before 1972 Beulah uncovered an “oblong bentwood box” containing many documents and letters relating to the history of the Meyer homestead. This sparked Beulah’s interest in the property and she used these documents, as well as others discovered after the death of her sister-in-law, to compose a history of the Rohr and Meyer families and the Meyer Homestead. She completed this account in December of 1984. Beulah Meyer died on December 9, 2006.
