**Abstract:** Henry Nickel immigrated to the United States from Mecklenberg, Germany in the mid-nineteenth century. The exact date of his birth and entry into the U.S. are unknown. In 1865 he built a house in Milwaukee, though he did not own the land until 1886. He lived in the house with his wife Maria (nee Klussendorf) until her death in 1895. Nine of their children were born in the house and one died there. Nickel died in his home on December 30, 1930. The house was removed by the city of Milwaukee after 1972.
