Abstract: The Works Progress Administration (WPA) was one of President Franklin Roosevelt's New Deal agencies during the Great Depression. The Milwaukee County Office of the WPA was created on November 1, 1935 and operated continuously until 1942. The program provided numerous jobs for the unemployed to work on county bridges, roads and parks or perform clerical work for the city and county. WPA projects also focused on social and cultural efforts. Artists painted murals in schools and public buildings; writers researched and wrote regional and state guidebooks; and orchestras played concerts in new areas. Less skilled individuals found work on various handicraft projects as well.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of numerically arranged project case files; case files on the Myra Peach Historical Costume Pageant, the Handicraft Project and Writer's Project; correspondence, memoranda, newspaper clippings, reports, artwork and other ephemera.
