Abstract: In September 1965, the U.S. Congress established the Father Marquette Tercentenary Commission to commemorate the 300th anniversary of Jacques Marquette's explorations of the northern Great Lakes and Mississippi River Valley. The commission set aside the years 1968-1973 to honor Marquette. President Lyndon Johnson appointed James C. Windham, president of Pabst Brewing Company, as chairman of the national commission. Eliot Fitch of the Marine National Bank chaired the Wisconsin of the State Commission. The commission authorized several events to honor Father Marquette, including the composition of a special symphony, a symposium, and the awarding of Marquette University's first Pere Marquette Discovery Medal to the Apollo 11 astronauts. In addition, the Apostle Islands on Wisconsin's Chequamegon Bay was the site of much of Marquette's missionary work, and as a result, it was designated a national park.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of correspondence, programs, photos, newspaper clippings, and other ephemera from James Windham and Arnold Winograd, also of Pabst Brewing.
