Abstract: The General Society of Colonial Wars was founded in New York in 1892 for the purpose of furthering the interest in, and study of, America's Colonial history for the period between the settlement of Jamestown, Virginia on May 13, 1607, and the battle of Lexington on April 19, 1775. The Wisconsin Chapter was formed in Kenosha in April 1897.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of anniversary books, lists of ancestors, roll calls, publications, and constitutions/bylaws pertaining to the General Society and other state chapters.
