Abstract: In 1953, a group of families from the Ravenswood neighborhood in Wauwatosa formed a Missouri Synod Lutheran congregation. Initially, the congregation was designated Ravenswood Lutheran Church until the name St. Mark's Lutheran Church was adopted in April 1954. Services were held in buildings on the Milwaukee County Preventorium grounds, but a new church was constructed at 550 N. 95th Street in Milwaukee and formally dedicated in 1957. Clarence Bickel, a partner with Robert W. Baird, was one of the charter members.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of photos, church histories/directories, revised constitutions/bylaws, annual and financial reports, newspaper clippings and other ephemera.
