

**Title:** Sammond, Frederic Collection

**Abstract:** Frederic Sammond (1895-1966) was a Milwaukee native. During World War I, he served as a captain with the 120<sup>th</sup> Field Artillery Regiment. He was a self-taught attorney who began practicing in Milwaukee in 1927 and became a senior partner in the Foley, Sammond and Lardner firm. He served on the board of directors of several Milwaukee companies and was involved with multiple civic organizations, including serving as a member of the Board of Curators at the State Historical Society of Wisconsin.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of a June 15, 1965 speech Sammond gave at the unveiling of a marker at UW-Milwaukee noting the location of Milwaukee-Downer College.
