**Abstract:** August Story was born in Marblehead in April 1812 and graduated from Harvard College in 1832. Thereafter, he taught and studied law in Baltimore before relocating to Milwaukee in 1836. He was elected a member of the Wisconsin Territorial Legislature in 1838 and served until 1840. He returned to Salem where he served as president of the Holyoke Insurance Company, president of the Salem National Bank, and on Salem's Common Council. He passed away in 1882.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of memorial resolutions from the Pioneer Association of Milwaukee, the Holyoke Insurance Company, and the Salem National Bank. In oversize, the collection includes a land indenture between Augustus Story and Samuel H. Graves for parcel of land in Michigan, Feb. 1837.
