**Abstract:** The S.M. Siesel Company was incorporated in 1922 as a general contractor. In 1935, Siesel Construction Company was organized to take over the construction business as a wholly owned subsidiary. The subsidiary was dissolved on October 31, 1940, and the corporate name of S.M. Siesel Co. was changed to Siesel Construction Co. The company built the Milwaukee County Courthouse, the Plankinton Arcade, the Shorecrest Hotel and Mount Sinai Hospital. located at 514 E. Ogden Avenue in Milwaukee
