**Abstract:** Fannie Watson Terry was born in Geneva, New York, in July 1864. Her father was a Presbyterian minister who eventually relocated to Wisconsin to serve a congregation at Waukesha before he moved on to Spokane, Washington. Fannie graduated from the Milwaukee Female College and married Frank T. Terry of Milwaukee in 1893. She passed away in Milwaukee in September 1950.
