Abstract: Carl Trieschmann, Robert C. Spencer and others founded the Wisconsin Phonological Institute in 1879 to facilitate the establishment of day schools for deaf pupils. A classroom was opened in the old West Side School in 1883, which eventually expanded into a full graded school.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of Josephine Bearmann's diploma from the Normal Department of the Wisconsin Phonological Institute (1893); a picture of Alexander Graham Bell; a booklet by Paul Binner – principal of the Milwaukee Day School for the Deaf and Normal Department – entitled *Guide to the Binner Chart of Vocal Gymnastics for the Deaf and the Hearing*; and a booklet of shadowgraphs.
