**Abstract:** Milwaukee native Robert Wild was born November 12, 1875. He graduated from the University of Wisconsin Law School in 1899 and became a prominent Milwaukee attorney. He was noted as a great orator and historian and was a former president of the Milwaukee Bar Association. He passed away in October 1928.
