Abstract: In 1917, the Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod was separated from the Evangelical Lutheran Joint Synod of Wisconsin and other States. To administer the church's work more effectively, Wisconsin was divided into three districts: the Northern, the Western, and the Southeastern.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of two issues of *The Northwestern Lutheran* (1966); three issues of the *WELS Historical Institute Journal* (1983-1987); a 50th anniversary history *Faith of Our Fathers 1917-1967*; a booklet entitled *Where Do We Stand?* (1950); a newsletter (1984); and a U.S. Bicentennial proclamation.
