**Abstract:** August F. Gallun and Albert Trostel formed a leather business in Milwaukee in 1858. Eventually, the two partners established their own tanneries. A. F. Gallun & Sons (August’s son Albert F. and August H. joined the company and eventually took over as president) grew into one of the largest tanneries in Milwaukee and one of the four largest tanneries in the United States. The tannery, however, closed in 1993 primarily due to cheaper overseas competition. Several buildings in the tannery complex were razed in the early 2000’s, and others were refurbished into condominiums.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of ledgers, correspondence, reports, minutes, blueprints/floor plans and other ephemera that detail the tannery’s operations. Also included is material pertaining to August F. Gallun’s estate.

**Access:** No restrictions

**Administrative Notes:** The collection was donated in January 2014 by Siegel Gallagher Management. It was processed by Kevin Abing in 2015.
