Abstract: The Milwaukee Debate League (MDL) was established in 2006 through a 3-year seed grant from the Einhorn Family Charitable Trust. Conducted through Marquette University's Diederich College of Communication, it is an urban education program in which more than 150 students and 25 teachers from 15 Milwaukee high schools participate. The MDL establishes debate programs, trains teachers and students, and sponsors tournaments and workshops. Its goal is to positively change the lives of participating students by increasing school attendance, improving oral reading and comprehension skills, increasing grade point averages, reducing disciplinary referrals, and increasing rates of high school graduation and admission to college.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a DVD concerning the Debate League as well as a photo album/booklet.
