Abstract: Gustave Kaumeimer (1862-1932) came to Milwaukee at age seven with his mother and brothers, Julius and William. He attended the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Chicago (class of 1887) where he was a pupil and protégé of famed surgeon Dr. Nicholas Senn. After interning at both Cook County and Milwaukee County hospitals, Kaumheimer joined the staff of the latter. He also was a consulting physician at Deaconess and Johnston Emergency hospitals. His wife, Jennie, was a pioneer in the nursing field as a member of the first graduating class of nurses from the Milwaukee County Hospital. She passed away in 1932, one day after her husband.
