**Abstract:** The Wisconsin Public Service Corporation was established in 1883 as the Oshkosh Gas Light Company. It was incorporated in 1922 as the Wisconsin Public Service Corporation. It was owned by the Wisconsin Securities Company. Shortly thereafter, Wisconsin Securities merged WPS with five other utilities it owned to serve Oshkosh, Green Bay, Sheboygan and Manitowoc. Mergers and acquisitions continued throughout the decades, and as of 2015, WPS is a separate utility owned by a new parent company, WEC Energy Group.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of annual and quarterly reports, prospectus, and other ephemera.
