Historical Note: The Calumet Club began as the Junge Deutsche Kaufleute (Young German Merchants) in 1884. The Calumet Club featured club rooms, parlors, a library, bowling alleys and women's reception rooms where large social gatherings took place. Because of dwindling membership in the Prohibition era the club voted itself out of existence in May 1924.
