**Scope and Content:** Bronzeville was a historic neighborhood in Milwaukee, bordered by State St. to North Ave. and 3<sup>rd</sup> St. to 12<sup>th</sup> St., that was home to a large segment of Milwaukee's African American population. Bronzeville was a center for black culture and economic growth in segregated Milwaukee from the 1930s through the 1960s. The neighborhood hosted thousands of black individuals who migrated northward to escape the rural American South.
