Historical Note: John Cooper was an early Milwaukee County pioneer who arrived here in 1837, taking-up residence in what was to become North Greenfield. Cooper served as Assistant Postmaster, Justice of the Peace and as a member of the county Board from North Greenfield. He died in 1900, being then over 90 years of age. His son John H. Cooper lived on the Mukwonago Road near North Greenfield and raised cash crops that he apparently sold through Milwaukee commission merchants. Many recipes from these transactions are included in the collection and give an idea what produce Cooper was raising, market prices, and commission merchant percentages.
