Abstract: The First Wisconsin National Bank's roots reach back to the founding of the Farmer's and Millers Bank in Milwaukee in 1853. Through internal growth and various mergers, it became First Wisconsin National Bank in 1919. The company changed names several times, becoming Firstar in 1988. In 2001, Firstar bought out U.S. Bancorp, based in Minneapolis, Minnesota, and assumed that company's name and moved its headquarters to Minneapolis.
