Abstract: Ernest Flagg was a noted New York architect in the Beaux-Arts style (greatly influenced by French ideas of architectural design).

Scope and Content: The collection consists of material on Milwaukee-area homes designed by architect Ernest Flagg which includes National Register of Historic Places Nomination form, notice of entry in National Register with list of area properties, article by Flagg on small houses, and clippings and articles on homes – including a *Wisconsin Academy Review* article by Richard W.E.
