Historical Note: Mildred De Courcy was a speech teacher at South Division High School. This collection, which spans the years 1920 to 1945, contains much information on the play “Briar Rose” which she directed in 1937. The original book, lyrics and libretto are in the collection as well as her notes, revisions, etc. Reference is also made to W.P.A., which made costumes for the production.

Scope and Content: The collection also contains her school essays, teaching notes, student papers, journal/notebook and general education information. Personal correspondence, some financial information and a Rawlings family history are also included.
