Abstract: Shirley Marine was born in Milwaukee in June 1930. She earned her bachelor's degree in English from Milwaukee-Downer College in 1952 and went on to work as an assistant Publications-Exhibits-Radio & TV with the Milwaukee Public Library from 1953 to 1965 and as Information Officer/Public Affairs Officer with the Milwaukee Public Museum from 1965 to 1986.
