Types of printing performed by the company included direct mail advertising, college annual engraving and printing, trade papers, house organs, magazines and general commercial work.

**Scope and Content:** The collection contains corporate record books, appraisals, and correspondence, financial documents, board minutes, advertisements, and an annual report. The collection also includes obituaries of the firm's founders, Silas Kortmeyer and Paul Hammersmith.
