Historical Note: Walter Hintz was a long-time member of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors. He was born on February 8, 1894, and at one time, was a member of the Socialist Party, the LaFollette Progressive Party, and the Farmer-Labor-Progressive Federation. In 1940, he was elected to the County Board to represent the 2nd District. He served in that capacity until ill health forced him to retire in 1964. He also served on the Board of Directors of the Milwaukee County Historical Society. He died in November 1965 from a heart attack. The records consist of reports, publications, minutes, correspondence, clippings, and sheet music.
