Abstract: The Wisconsin District Garden Clubs were a conglomerate of garden clubs in the greater Milwaukee area. They were women's clubs who developed various gardening projects to beautify the area and promote conservation. The Wisconsin Garden Club Federation, which is included in the collection, was a charter member of the Roadside Development Institute whose objective was to promote conservation, preservation, and improve the roadsides in Wisconsin.

Scope and Content: The collection includes information about the Roadside Development Institute, miscellaneous conservation information, state park bulletins for Wisconsin, news clippings and announcements for the garden clubs, information about WWII Victory Gardens, garden club yearbooks, garden club programs, and garden club meetings and promotional fliers.
