Historical Note: George Hampel, Jr. was very active professionally and publicly in education, labor, charitable and civic causes. The bulk of this collection represents the time he spent as a member of the Milwaukee Board of School Directors from 1947 to 1963 until his move to Iowa with the United Cerebral Palsy Association. He served as School Board president from July 1955 to July 1956. Other parts of this collection deal with Hampel's appointment as Director of Publicity and Research for the Wisconsin State Federation of Labor, and Regional Director for United Cerebral Palsy. Hampel, Jr. was also chairman of the Radio and Television Committee of the Cleaner Milwaukee Committee, member of the Milwaukee Public Library Board of Trustees and Milwaukee County Board of Public Welfare, chairman of the Milwaukee Motorist's Public Auto Parks Committee, vice-president and curator of the Wisconsin State Historical Society, involved with Socialist and Progressive issues, and an active member of the Methodist church. Hampel's father was George Sr., owner of Hampel's Book Shop Inc., and Hampel Jr.'s son is George Hampel III.
