Abstract: Charles Komassa was born on February 15, 1908 and attended South Division High School. He worked as a court reporter for Milwaukee County as well as committee clerk for the Milwaukee County Board, but the theater was his first love. From 1931 to 1941 he directed and acted in plays for church organizations, and from 1941 to 1951 he acted and directed the Norman Players, an amateur theater troupe he organized. He passed away in 1993 at the age of 85.

Scope and Content: The collection contains correspondence, photos, programs and newspaper clippings documenting Komassa's involvement with the Norman Players. Also included is a script by Komassa in honor of West Milwaukee's Golden Jubilee, 1956.
