Abstract: P. Cornelius Mack Hall was a native Milwaukeean and an air force veteran. In 1961 he began working for the Milwaukee County Department of Public Welfare as a case worker and with the Wisconsin State department of Public Welfare, Division of Corrections as a probation and parole agent and institution social worker.

The Inner City Development Project (ICDP) was a community action anti-poverty program sponsored by the United Community Services of Greater Milwaukee. Its primary purpose was to establish rapport and work with multi-problem families and hard to reach, hard to serve youth. There were two Milwaukee offices; one was located at 2700 N. 3rd Street and the other on the corner of 16th and Greenfield, Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Scope and Content: The collection contains material relating to the time period when Hall was actively engaged as the Community Organization Specialist for the ICDP. The collection contains publications and statements published by the ICDP and Mr. Hall's correspondence.
