Abstract: William (Bill) Lemieux, born in Oshkosh, but a long-time resident of Milwaukee, earned his BA in political science at University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh, and earned a MA in History at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. He assisted John F Kennedy’s 1960 primary in Wisconsin and then served as an aide to President Kennedy during his presidency. Later in the decade, Bill co-authored a campaign manual for Senator Eugene McCarthy’s bid for the presidency in 1968. In 1972, Bill unsuccessfully challenged incumbent William F O’Donnell for the position of the 4th District Milwaukee County Supervisor seat. In addition to his political activism, Bill obtained a Wisconsin State Teacher’s Certificate and worked for four decades with special education students in the Milwaukee Public School System.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of personal and political correspondence, political ephemera, professional correspondence, and various published materials.
