**Historical Note:** Frank A. and Charles M. Inbusch were born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Charles graduated from Riverview Military Academy. For a time the two brothers operated Inbusch Storage and Trucking Company (which later became Hansen Storage Company). Charles also worked as a life insurance company inspector. He died May 24, 1966.

**Abstract:** The collection contains correspondences to Col. Horace M. Seaman generally concerning Wisconsin National Guard matters. A partial genealogy is given in an application to the “Society of Colonial Wars” in the back of the undated 1890 file. The collection also includes a diary (1849 – 1850) of Joshua Stark (grandfather) and autograph book belonging to Amy Orton Eaume, mother of Charles Inbusch’s wife.
