**Historical Note:** The collection is comprised of documentation pertaining to the career of Robert Fanello, an engineer at A.O. Smith Corp. The majority pertains to his trip to and work in Rio de Janeiro, where A.O. Smith was contracted to help construct a hydroelectric power plant. The Forcacava Pipe Project began in 1952 and finished in 1954. When completed, it supplied 330,000 kilowatts of power, and cost approximately 100 million dollars. Other aspects of the collection are family histories and photos before Robert's generation.
