Abstract: Washington High School was established in 1911 by the Milwaukee School Board to serve students around the intersection of 38th Street and Clarke. Major additions to and renovations of the buildings occurred in 1924, the 1950s, the 1970s, and 1984. The school is now Washington High School of Information Technology, described by Milwaukee Public Schools as "a magnet high school providing technology-integrated academics."

Scope and Content: The collection includes three programs for Washington High School class reunions, for the 25th reunion of the Class of 1949 (1974), for the 40th reunion of the Class of 1952 (1992), and for the 50th reunion of the Class of 1949 (1999). The collection also includes the program for Washington High School's 100 Year Celebration: "Yesterday, Today & Tomorrow" (2011).
