Historical Note: Reverend William A. Passavant, Pastor of the First English Lutheran Church in Pittsburgh, was inspired in 1846 to introduce an American model of the European Deaconess Institution and Hospital at Kaiserwerth on the Rhine in the United States. Pastor Fliedner dedicated the first Protestant Hospital in America on July, 17, 1849. Sister Elizabeth Hupperts, Paulina Ludwig, Louisa Hendricksen, and Elizabeth Hess were the first group of deaconesses to travel to America.

In 1863 a Milwaukee Hospital was established, Sister Barbara Kaag serving as matron and Rev. Schlatermund as director. In 1883 a new 70 bed hospital was built with a Chapel at the north end of the hospital property. A Deaconess Motherhouse was established in May 1893. The School of Nursing was established in 1903, and the first class of seven women graduated in 1906. Fredrick Layton and his wife donated money in 1908 to establish the Layton Home for invalids.

Abstract: The collection contains material relating to the Lutheran Hospital of Milwaukee, including patient registers, account books, publications, and yearbooks from the Nursing School.
