

Title: Kinnickinnic River

Abstract: The Kinnickinnic River is one of three Milwaukee County rivers that flows into Lake Michigan. It travels for about 9.6 miles, and over the years has been modified with concrete channeling to reinforce the river and adapt to the growing population in Milwaukee.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a report "Kinnickinnic River Watershed Planning Program Prospectus," 1974, and a public notice issued on March 7, 2000. The public notice stipulates that the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will assess the river for environmental impacts. In addition, the collection contains a pamphlet, "How the Kinnickinnic Should Look" written by Charles Whitnall.
