Abstract: Milwaukee County conducted an air pollution control program with the establishment of the Department of Smoke Regulation in 1948. The Department of Air Pollution Control was formally created in 1961, and its scope was expanded to regulate smoke and dust particle emissions and develop regulations regarding combustion process and incineration emissions. By 1980, these functions fell within the Engineering, Energy and Environment Section within the Department of Transportation and Public Works.
