POSITION:

Collections and Exhibits Volunteer

SUPERVISOR:

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Projects will vary based on the current needs of the department. General duties may include donation processing, artifact rehousing, artifact research, and exhibit research.

Example Opportunities:

- Set-up and take-down of annual exhibit (runs January-April)
- Use CatalogIt to update collections records
- Work on inventory project and proper rehousing of artifacts

REQUIREMENTS:

Volunteers must be able to communicate effectively, be dependable, and have the ability to work independently and within a team setting. Volunteers must be 18 years or older or accompanied by an adult. Role may require standing, navigation of busy or cramped workspaces, climbing ladders, and the ability to lift 20lbs. Accommodations may be possible and can be discussed at your interview.

TIME COMMITMENT:

Minimum time commitment can be discussed based on any school requirements and projects.

TRAINING:

Needed training provided.
