POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Want to be more involved with the Historical Society, but have limited time? This is the position for you!

The Historical Society participates in approximately 20 special events each year, hosted at the Historical Center in downtown Milwaukee, Trimborn Farm in Greendale, Kilbourntown House in Shorewood, as well as other offsite locations. We are looking for volunteers to act as food and ticket sellers, security-stationed docents, set-up and take-down, etc. Additional opportunities to help with event preparation such as assistance with mailings, outreach, and marketing are also available.

Example Events:

- Exhibit-based programming for annual exhibition (Historical Center, downtown Milwaukee)
- Annual Trimborn Farm Harvest of Arts & Crafts (Greendale)
- Annual clean ups at Trimborn Farm and Kilbourntown House
- A Very Merry Milwaukee: Pictures with Santa Event (Historical Center, downtown Milwaukee)

REQUIREMENTS:

Volunteers must be 18 years or older or accompanied by an adult. Individuals with a background in customer service, event planning, and communications are encouraged to apply. Seated positions are available and other accommodations can be discussed.

TIME COMMITMENT:

Time commitment varies based on event but once accepted as a volunteer, you must work two shifts a year to remain active.

TRAINING:

Minimal event specific training may be needed.

BENEFITS:

- Free family admission to the Milwaukee County Historical Society's Historic Sites.
- Discount of 40% on membership in the Milwaukee County Historical Society.
- Opportunities to participate in Museum programs, events, and activities.

A criminal background check may be conducted prior to volunteering
