

**Title:** Pfeil, William R. Papers

**Abstract:** William Pfeil was second bass in the Lyric Glee Club and the Lyric Male Chorus. The Lyric Glee Club was organized in 1896 and incorporated in 1913 with the purpose of promoting the “art of male chorus singing” and the “advancement of music.” In the early 1920s, the organization’s name was changed to the Lyric Male Chorus.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of programs for the Glee Club and Male Chorus, a short history of the Lyric Male Chorus, newspaper clippings and some personal items belonging to Pfeil.
