**Abstract:** A.T. Van Scoy was born in 1855 in New York state. He relocated to Milwaukee and found work with the Milwaukee Harvester Company (later the International Harvester Company). During World War I, he served with the state Council of Defense as Milwaukee County’s Food Administrator. He passed away in 1921.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of a memorial in the February 1921 *Harvester World* magazine and a certificate of membership in the Commercial Law League of America. Also included are the following oversize items: a diploma from Mount Union College, 1876; an appointment to the State Council of Defense, 1917; a certificate of service on the State Council of Defense; and an appointment as Food Administrator, 1917-1918.
