**Abstract:** Robert Schuffenhauer was born in Milwaukee in January 1884. He represented the Socialist Party as an election commissioner for the City of Milwaukee for 25 years and worked in the banking industry for 45 years. He was secretary-treasurer of the Commonwealth Mutual Savings Bank for 15 years and was elected president in January 1963 but resigned on August 1, 1963. He passed away in 1967.

**Scope and Content:** The collection consists of a tribute from the Milwaukee Election Commission re Schuffenhauer's 25 years of service; his will, probate records and financial/stock documents. Also included is his marriage certificates and miscellaneous material related to Commonwealth Mutual Savings Bank, Arthur Schuffenhauer, Esther E. Carlson and Edward Schuffenhauer. In oversize, there is Robert's 8<sup>th</sup> grade diploma from Milwaukee Public Schools, 1898.
