Abstract: The Wisconsin Education Association was formed in 1853 as a statewide educational organization of teachers and administrators. It evolved into a teacher's union that worked to improve members' lives through collective action, legislation, professional development and support and public relations. In 1972, the organization changed its name to the Wisconsin Education Association Council.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a 1949 annual convention program, the *WEA News and Views* newsletter, 1967, the 1943-44 Wisconsin Reading Circle annual, and issues of *Wisconsin Journal of Education*, 1940-1973 (not inclusive).
