Abstract: John Shadbolt and Francis Boyd established the Shadbolt & Boyd Iron Company in 1863, In 1882, Henry Hunter joined the firm, and the name was changed to Shadbolt, Boyd & Company. The company was a wholesale dealer in iron and steel goods. The company was eventually succeeded by T&A Industrial Distributors.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of a bond portfolio, business records, company product catalogs, 1905, 1931 and 1947 and a copy of Greenfield's Pocket Guide for Machinists.
