Abstract: Clinton Walworth was born in New York and settled in Milwaukee in 1836. He was one of the earliest lawyers in Milwaukee and served a variety of posts in the area—Master of Chancery, Police Justice, and Judge. He passed away in July 1862.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of certificates of appointment, correspondence, a family genealogy, a membership certificate for the Juneau Guards, insurance policy with the Milwaukee Mutual Fire Insurance Company, tax records and various property-related deeds.
