Abstract: The Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) was a fraternal organization founded in 1866 to help Civil War veterans of the Union Army, Navy, Marines and Revenue Cutter Service maintain connections with each other. The organization quickly grew to include hundreds of local GAR posts across the nation, and at its peak in 1890 had more than 490,000 members. The GAR also became a powerful political and advocacy group, supporting primarily Republican political candidates, lobbying Congress for veterans’ pensions, and promoting patriotic education. Among Milwaukee’s GAR posts were the E.B. Wolcott Post, the Robert Chivas Post No. 2 and the Rank and File Post No. 240.

Scope and Content: The collection consists of correspondence, programs, proceedings, reports, clippings, personal war sketch books and other material related to Milwaukee’s G.A.R. posts and various national encampments.
