History: The Railroad Commission was created in 1905 for the regulation of railroads. Its scope of authority has been extended into regulation of common carrier motor vehicles, public utility rates, securities, and water power. The Commission consists of three members each appointed for a term of six years. Appointments are made by the Governor with consent of the Senate.
