**History:** The William Reckmeyer Company was one of the most enduring furriers in Milwaukee. William Reckmeyer, founder of the company, left his hometown of Haderslev, Denmark, in 1884 to avoid forced military service in the Prussian army. He initially located in Canada and put his knowledge of the fur business, which he had learned from his father, to work. He then moved to Detroit and helped older brother Adolph with his fur shop before eventually settling in Milwaukee. In 1886, William established his own fur business on the third floor of the Windsor Hotel on Milwaukee Street. Word of William's expertise quickly spread, and the business soon outgrew its cramped quarters. The following year, William relocated the company to 410 Milwaukee Street. The venture continued to thrive and moved into a new space at 327 E. Wisconsin Avenue in 1891. In 1901, William's younger brother, Emil, emigrated to Milwaukee and joined the company. That same year, the firm, needing still larger accommodations, moved into a new store at 301 E. Wisconsin. There the store remained, until Victor Reckmeyer moved the store to a new five-story building at 331 E. Wisconsin in 1955. The company eventually passed on to Victor's son, William, who managed the firm until it closed its doors in 1999.

## **Scope and Content:**

The bulk of the records consist of clippings of newspaper advertisements, but it also includes several scrapbooks, invoices and photos.
